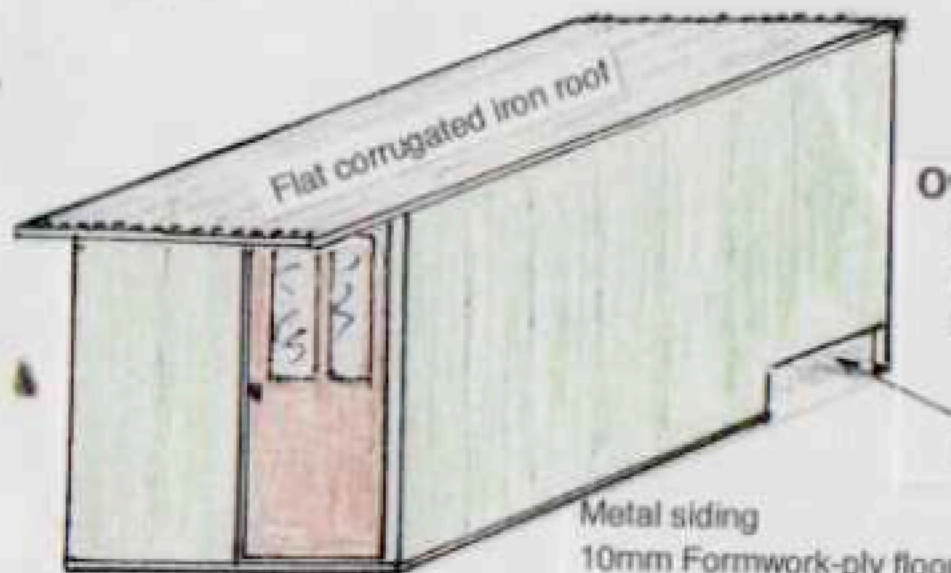


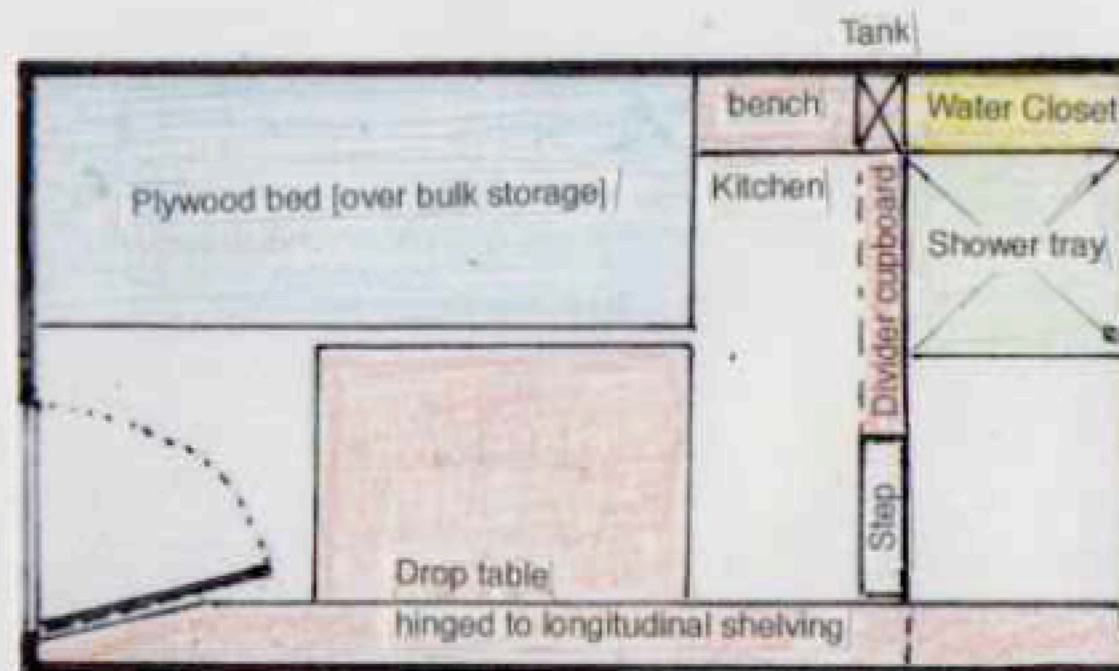
## Smallest H4h unit for single occupancy



### Overall Dimensions

Height 2.1 m  
 Width 1.8 m (smallest)  
 Length:  
 Main room 2.6m +  
 Shower/toilet 0.6m [raised]  
 Front overhang approx. 0.6m

Metal siding  
 10mm Formwork-ply floor  
 3mm ply walls and ceiling liner (full sheets)

## Homes for the Homeless

*"Built by the homeless"*

- Fully featured — with toilet, hot shower, cooking, and washing
- Indoor or outdoors — with insulated cavity walls.
- Secure — lockable and personal storage spaces
- Provides itinerant homeless with a personal address.
- Cheap — within donation range of many individuals and companies
- Demountable in a few hours and easily truckable/moveable
- Designed for community clusters or lone residences
- Flat-packed for easy storage — suited for emergencies.
- Mass-produced from standard hardware and timber sizes
- Volunteer construction force — any age; no skills needed
- Only basic tools required: electric drill, hammer, handsaw
- Fabricated as panels at bench height (no climbing)
- No factor or assembly lines — underground car park
- No tradesmen needed for erection on site.
